

# Florida Karting Series Championship Year-end awards for 2026

2026 class championship title for Rookie class will be earned from a combination of A and B race class points. From the 5 state events a total of the Award class "A" and Award class "B" will result in 2 points finishes per event for a total of 10 countable races. The best 8 of 10 race finishes will determine the overall champion. Each racer must race 6 of the 10 class races to be eligible for year-end awards.

**Best 8 of 10 will calculate Overall Vega State Champion. Must have entered 6 events to receive Yr-end awards**

In all other classes, the champion will be determined from the best 4 of 5 races in each class.

The class champions in the following classes will receive a 1st place leather jacket/suit at the 2026 awards ceremony: Rookie, Junior 1, Junior 2, Junior 3, Stock Medium, Stock Heavy, Stock Super Heavy, Masters, Ducar 212, and Champs if the average entry count is met. The champions in these classes will have the option of blue or black Vega Champion leather jackets or driving suit depending on supply. (\* If a class continues and doesn't meet entry count, winner can request about a Championship jacket at racer's cost)

Additional Awards: 2nd through 5th place in year-end points, in all above classes, will receive a prize package to all racers running 3 of the 5 events or 6 of 10 races in Rookie. Award ceremony payouts will be to 5<sup>th</sup> place minimums in all classes to those who qualify having class averages met.

Pro Class Champions in: Pro Junior 1, Pro Junior 2, Pro Junior 3, Pro Ducar 212, Pro Medium, Pro Heavy, Semi-Pro, and Pro Super Heavy will receive a large Championship Vega Cup to signify their accomplishments along with their **cash awards** from each event. (for the 2026 season jackets/suits will be offered at racer's cost). Places 2<sup>nd</sup> on out have received payouts during the season in these classes. *In years past, additional sponsors have stepped up to help offset with Jacket/suits for Champions.*

Any class with average entries of 5.0 or less may receive alternate year end awards. This rule pertains to all classes.

## 2026 Season Award eligibility:

Best 4 of 5 events calculating for point championship titles events but must have raced 3 of the 5 events in that class to qualify for awards.

Best 8 of 10 races calculating for point championship titles in Rookie and Spec Crate classes. Must race 6 of the 10 races in that class to qualify for awards.

Special note on class minimums: Any class not carrying an average of 4.0 or more after the second event may be dropped due to lack of attendance.

Any Local Option classes will have year-end awards decided upon class average entries and are not guaranteed.

**For the year of 2026, we will hold an Awards Race Ceremony that will be tentatively scheduled in September or October.**
